



Evaluation opinion on the report of the main activities carried out by the Center of Studies on Migrations and Intercultural Relations (CEMRI) in the period 2018-2023

In the period (2018-2023), researchers from CEMRI's five research groups, coming from different scientific areas (social, human and health sciences), belonging to the Aberta University and other university institutions, developed a broad and diverse scientific activity perspective articulated and collaborative, multidisciplinary and interdisciplinary. The researchers' activities focused on different thematic areas: mobilities, cultures, interculturalities, migrations and refugees; cultural diversities, intercultural relations and social integration; identities, cultural expressions, cultural and migration rights and policies; social, cultural and digital inclusion; intercultural communication and education in different contexts; studies on women, gender, society and culture; health, culture, development, gender, health education and communication, especially in intercultural and migratory contexts, cultural and psychological adaptation and clinical and intercultural psychopathology; and also media and research activities and cultural production in cultural, artistic and technological mediations, as well as visual and virtual anthropology, media and mediations and audiovisual and digital participatory research methodologies.

These activities produced publications in international and national books and magazines in different languages and their dissemination in an open scientific repository, such as the Aberta University Repository, in addition to the organisation by CEMRI and conjunction with other institutions of numerous conferences, seminars and national congresses and international development, scientific dissemination and training through multiple communications, conferences and workshops at scientific events, university postgraduate programs and other associations and training initiatives in the community. CEMRI researchers have participated in numerous scientific committees of international scientific congresses and on boards and editorial committees of national and international books and magazines. They collaborated with several international research centres and groups and postgraduate programs at European and non-European universities and in research projects, international and national, European and extra-European, as well as those related to advanced training (master's degrees, doctorates and post-doctorates).
